

Dried Mango

Bright, low-fibre dried mango strips and chunks for the EU snack and ingredient market.

Origin: Tanzania

Quality

- Moisture 14–17% for shelf stability and texture.
- Non-fibrous, free-flowing pieces — not sticky or clinging.
- Bright yellow / light orange colour, free of black dots or white spots.
- Cut sizes: 5–8 cm fingers/strips or 3 cm chunks.
- Low-fibre varieties with clear mango flavour and sweet-tart balance.
- Batch moisture analysis and homogenisation before dispatch.
- Unpreserved / no-sulphur option, conventional metabisulphite pre-treatment with MRL compliance, or citric/ascorbic acid options for organic positioning.

Quantity

- Minimum order: 1 FCL, negotiable by destination.
- Sample lots from 100 kg.
- Volumes aggregated from selected low-fibre varieties in Tanzania's Northern Zone through established farmers' associations and AMCOS networks.
- Programmed monthly shipments available against annual contracts.

Certificates

- HACCP minimum at processing partner level, BRC preferred.
- GlobalGAP-aligned sourcing with documented HACCP implementation.
- EU Organic option available.
- Batch laboratory analysis report and moisture certificate.
- EUDR-ready traceability with GPS-mapped farm plots.

Packaging

- High-quality transparent blue polythene bulk bags; 2.5 kg nitrogen-flushed preferred (vacuum avoided to prevent clumping).
- Two-ply cartons of 10 / 15 / 20 kg.
- Cold-chain transport in reefer containers at 5 °C.
- Labelling: product name, batch/lot codes, net metric weight, best-before date, storage conditions, country of origin and packer details.

Prices

- Pricing is quoted per lot against current origin market levels, quality grade and destination — indicative offers issued within 2 working days of enquiry.
- Quotation basis: FOB Dar es Salaam, CFR / CIF EU port, or DAP buyer warehouse (Incoterms 2020).
- Offers valid 7 calendar days unless otherwise stated; contract pricing available for annual volume commitments.
- Payment terms: 30% advance on contract, balance against copy documents, or irrevocable L/C at sight. Alternative terms negotiable for repeat buyers.

Delivery terms

- Incoterms 2020: FOB, CFR, CIF or DAP as agreed in the sales contract.
- Port of loading: Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. Air freight from Kilimanjaro (JRO) available for samples and urgent lots.
- Standard lead time: 3–5 weeks from confirmed order and pre-shipment sample approval.
- Export documentation: commercial invoice, packing list, bill of lading, certificate of origin, phytosanitary certificate, laboratory analysis report and traceability lot sheet.
- Each carton carries a lot code with a QR link to the digital traceability record (GPS-mapped farm plots, harvest dates, lab results, certificates).
- Reefer container dispatch and transport at 5 °C; cold-chain integrity documented per shipment.

All specifications are indicative and confirmed per contract and pre-shipment sample. Prices and delivery terms are subject to written offer. Buyer-specific limits, certifications and packaging formats can be accommodated on request.
